Dear Seniors and Juniors:

With the arrival of another school year about to begin, we invite you to fill out the enclosed application if you intend to drive to school. Parking is a privilege and along with that privilege comes expectations! There are some simple rules that ensure the safety and the respect of each other that need to be addressed.

All cars that park on school grounds must have a parking permit clearly displayed. The parking decal must be placed on the inside upper right windshield (passenger side). The student parking area is located on the right side of the parking lot. **In order to park in the student parking lot you must have a valid, updated parking permit visible.** You will be asked to leave the grounds if you are not in compliance with this request. **Students are not permitted to go to their cars during the course of the school day, including lunchtime.** Warwick Valley High School has a closed campus policy. This means that no student is permitted to leave school grounds without proper authorization. Consult the Student Handbook and/or Code of Conduct for details. Also, please be advised that students are not to transport other students unless they have proper authorization. Violating these rules may jeopardize your parking privilege.

The attached application must be completely filled out, signed by you and your parent or guardian and returned to the high school office. The summer office hours are 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. A **\$20.00** fee will be charged to replace a permit if it is lost or stolen during the school year. If you have late arrival or early leave, you must bring a copy of your schedule for verification and identification purposes.
